**COACHES INSURANCE**

**Section 1: Public Liability (Up to \$20 Million)**

The scope of cover under this section provides Legal Liability to third parties in respect of bodily injury or property damage, occurring as a result of negligence on the insured's behalf during the period of insurance.

The Policy provides Coaches with public liability cover, whilst acting within the scope of their duties and conforming to the rules and by-laws of Skate Australia.

Cover extends to include all activities which are related to Roller Sports which may be held anywhere in the world excluding USA and Canada. Including competitions, national titles, administration meetings and all officially recognised sport related functions, as long as they do not increase the insurers exposure to claim.

**Policy Extensions**

**Coaches Liability**

*Covering coaches for claims arising out of acts of negligence which result in bodily injury or property damage, not only to the person(s) in their care but also to the general public.*

**First Aid Treatment Risk**

*Relating to liability arising from the rendering of first aid or medical treatment given by medical persons appointed by the insured to provide first aid and other medical services.*

**Member to Member**

*Covering each member separately in respect of claims made against them by any insured person.*

**Care, Custody & Control**

*Relating to liability for damage to property in the care, custody or control of the insured. Cover also extends to cover Legal Liability arising from Loss or damage to employees and/or visitors clothing and personal effects.*

**Section 2: Errors and Omissions (Up to \$1 Million)**

This policy provides indemnity to coaches, officials and team managers against all sums which they shall become legally liable to pay as a result of any claims made against them, during the policy period and notified during the period of cover, for any 'wrongful act', error or omission in the course of the conduct, which arises out of participation in Roller Sports while in the scope of their duties and conforming to the rules and by-laws of Skate Australia.

A \$Nil excess is applicable to all Property Damage claims.

It is essential that, if a member becomes aware of any circumstances which may result in a claim under this section of the policy, that the insurer must be notified as soon as reasonably practicable. Such notice must be given to the insurance company in writing before the expiration of the policy period in which you first became aware of the circumstances.

This cover is provided on a "Claims Made" basis which means all claims must be reported in writing immediately upon any allegation of negligence being committed or reported to the coach.
